About RIIFF

The **Rhode Island International Film Festival**™ is the largest festival in New England, screening 175 titles in six days with an attendance in 2009 topping 27,000. Films screened came from 57 countries and 21 states in the U.S. There were 38 World Premieres and 48 U.S. Premieres. A total of 17 narrative features were screened along with 71 feature documentaries. RIIFF is considered "one of the most exciting new festivals to come along," says Chris Gore in the *Ultimate Film Festival Survival Guide* (2004). It is also a qualifying festival for the Short Film Academy Award through its affiliation with the Academy of Motion Picture Arts & Sciences. Out of over 7,000 film festivals held worldwide, only 65 have this affiliation. RIIFF is the only festival in New England with this accolade.
