### About Flickers

Flickers, now in its second decade, produces video, audio and film about the arts for television, festivals and other non-profit organizations. Flickers creates and produces educational programs that teach about the media arts. From the acclaimed Rhode Island International Film Festival held each August to a Japanese film festival held in conjunction with the Black Ships Festival in Newport to Flickers' award-winning arts and cultural television series, "Between Takes," to the Creative Impulse Awards to radio programming with "DoubleFeature" to the Jamestown Chamber Music Series, Flickers has brought live performances, great films and interviews with leading artists to live and television audiences for over 26 years.

### About RIIF

The Rhode Island International Film Festival™ is the largest festival in New England, screening 289 titles in six days with an attendance in 2008 topping 25,000. Films screened came from 63 countries and 34 states in the U.S. There were 51 World Premieres and 48 U.S. Premieres. A total of 36 narrative features were screened along with 77 feature documentaries. RIIF is considered "one of the most exciting new festivals to come along," says Chris Gore in the *Ultimate Film Festival Survival Guide* (2004). It is also a qualifying festival for the Short Film Academy Award through its affiliation with the Academy of Motion Picture Arts & Sciences. Out of over 7,000 film festivals held worldwide, only 62 have this affiliation. RIIF is the only festival in New England with this accolade.
